Reality Check

- · There is NO business case for a Pickering airport.
- NO price tag has been put on the building of this airport.
- Pickering airport will NOT be needed by 2027. The
 latest Needs Assessment Study merely said that
 2027–2037 was the most likely period during which
 Toronto Pearson would reach capacity. The Study
 also said that the date could be later, especially if
 passenger traffic failed to keep up with forecasts. By
 2012, Pearson was actually handling about 4 million
 fewer passengers than forecasted, pushing the date
 of possible need into the 2030s. So why this announcement now?
- Paving over our best farmland for "industrial development" is wildly irresponsible. Factories and offices can be built on any land. They don't need Class 1 farmland. Food farmers do.
- Farming and food processing are huge job creators and major economic drivers. Within 35 years, the world will have 2 billion more mouths to try to feed. The most secure jobs, in the future, will be in farming and in food production, to meet that growing need.
- Build it and they will NOT come. The USA is riddled with new or expanded airports that are severely under-used, sometimes almost empty. A few examples: MidAmerica (Illinois), Pittsburgh International, Cincinnati/Northern Kentucky.... They were built or enlarged at huge expense; they couldn't keep or attract business; they are drowning in debt or they are failing. Montreal's Mirabel wasn't needed and it failed. The industrial areas around such airports never materialized or are emptying out.

What's at stake?

- The loss of over 13,000 acres of prime farmland, important natural habitat, and the GTA's healthiest watersheds and freshwater streams.
- The loss of a vital food source on the doorstep of Canada's largest & fastest growing city.
- The loss of a non-renewable resource. Urban sprawl destroys more Class 1 farmland every day. We must protect it as if our lives depended on it – which one day they will.
